



MEDICATIONS THAT AFFECT THYROID FUNCTION TEST RESULTS: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW!



Supplements: Always Ask!

- Biotin at doses of 1 mg or higher
- Iodine or kelp
- Any “Thyroid Support”— sometimes they contain thyroid hormone!

Not sure if they are affecting the result? Stop biotin for 3 days or other supplements for 2 weeks and retest.

Amiodarone: A Special Case

- Test TSH levels before initiating amiodarone and every 6 months while taking it
- Can cause hypothyroidism or hyperthyroidism
- Also decreases conversion of T4 to T3. Expect higher T4 and lower T3 values. Trust the TSH!



Medications

- Decreases TSH: Prednisone \geq 20 mg
- Alters T4: Phenytoin, carbamazepine, and heparin. Trust the TSH!



Take Home Points:

1. Review all supplements and medications
2. Consider repeating thyroid tests prior to making a diagnosis
